Assignment Title: Consulting Services for Design Review and Construction Supervision on Pilot Schools

The Republic of Turkey has received a grant from EU to be administered by the World Bank toward the cost of the Education Infrastructure for Resilience Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for consulting services contract which will be implemented by the Ministry of National Education. The contract will be financed under the EU's FRIT Program for Turkey. Funds will be channeled to Turkey through a World Bank administrated trust fund.

The first phase of the consulting services ("the Services") include preparation of following items belongs to six (6) schools which has 42.000 m², in Adana:

- (i) Geotechnical surveys,
- (ii) Engineering designs,
- (iii) Technical specifications,
- (iv) Cost estimate,
- (v) Bill of quantities,
- (vi) Bidding documents

The duration of services is envisaged as two (2) months.

Second phase of the consulting services will include supervision services for the six (6) schools. The duration of services is envisaged as twelve (12) months excluding defects notification period.

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Experience in consulting services in the last five years,
- Experience in preparation of designs and design review and supervision services for building construction similar to the services defined above,
- Having no non-performing contract with Ministry of Education,
- Staffing and administrative capacity related to the consulting services.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 3.14 of the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016) ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. In case of a Joint Venture (JV), all members of the JV will be evaluated jointly for the purpose of short listing and shall be jointly and severally liable for the assignment and shall sign the contract in case of award is made to that JV group. Interested consultants should clearly indicate the structure of their “association” and the duties of the partners and sub consultants in their application. Unclear expression of interests in terms of “in association with” and/or “in affiliation with” and etc. may not be considered for short listing.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant’s Qualification (CQS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
